He has presented at legal conferences and CLE's across the United States on Law and Technology and is on the Editorial Council of E-Discovery Advisor Magazine by Advisor Media.


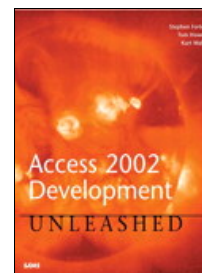
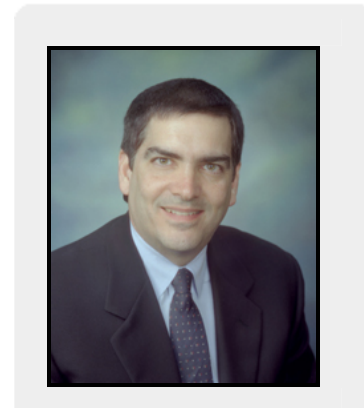
